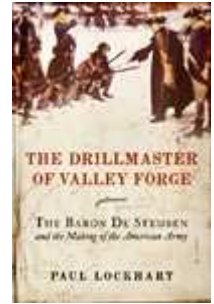

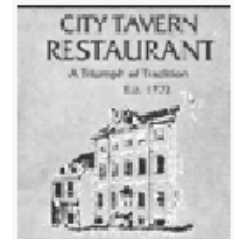

Paul Douglas Lockhart has been teaching history at Wright State since 1989, when he completed his Ph.D. under the direction of the late Gunther E. Rothenberg. He teaches courses on Scandinavian history, the "Age of Religious Wars," warfare in European history, and a variety of other topics on early modern and modern Europe. Dr. Lockhart was named National Endowment for the Humanities Visiting Distinguished Professor at the State University of New York/Potsdam College during the fall semester 2000.
